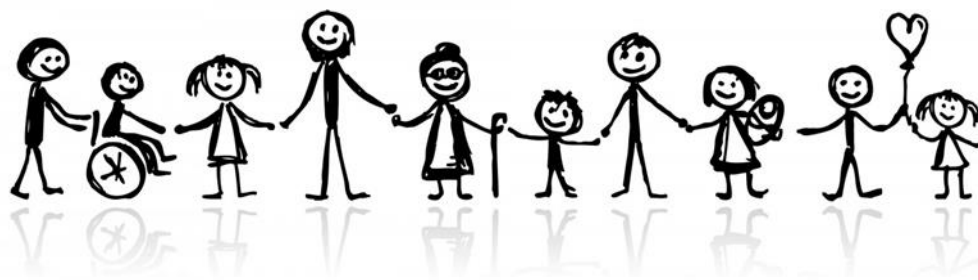


BELIEVE IN FAMILIES



The Early Help Assessment has been redesigned into 'My Family Plan'. Now it is in place and ratified by the LSCB and the Partnership Prevention Subgroup; we wish to offer training and support in the new assessment now known as My Family Plan.

The training is for one day, which will use a case study whereby you will be given the opportunity to complete a My Family Plan and hold reflective discussions and explore early help practice with families delivered by Schools and Academies. We will also explore setting SMART Actions Plans. We will put a plan together to support Education offering My Family Plans to children, young people and families from the Family Partnership Team in respect of the role of being Lead Practitioner offering Early Help.

It will be delivered by John Scadden, Family Partnership Team Manager, alongside Kay Venis, Assistant Head Teacher and Manager of Children Centre for Abingdon Primary School, Andy Appleyard, Headstart Reach and Ann Lovatt, Assistant Team Manager for Family Partnership Team.
