

**THRESHOLD TRAINING**

Middlesbrough Council has reviewed its training offer for the Thresholds resulting in the training being updated in line with Middlesbrough Children Services Transformation Programme. In addition the My Family Plan for Early Help & Prevention has been redesigned.

This will lead onto considering where Early Help & Prevention or Children Social Care involvement is applicable and supporting evidence based step ups.

We will then explore completing quality Safer Referrals and what challenges you experience from completing them. We will demonstrate and give you a copy of a 'good practice' example of a Safer Referral to take away.
